Re: Class Dojo App

I am writing to inform you that we have recently set up Class Dojo accounts for each child across the school. By now, you should have received a letter detailing how to download, join and set up your Class Dojo account for your child / children.

Class Dojo is a behaviour system we use in school where each child has an avatar that earns points for positive behaviours and great work in school. This means you will receive notifications every time your child receives a point for positive behaviours or for working hard.

In terms of data protection, all of your child's information is kept safe on ClassDojo. Only they, their teachers, and you as their parents can see their information. Additionally, each of the children are given an avatar, so their faces are not visible on the account.

Class Dojo will give you the facility to communicate with the class teacher. However, although you can message your child's class teacher through the Class Dojo app, we are asking parents to continue to email teachers directly or contact them via phone. We are looking into how we can develop Class Dojo even further in the near future.

We hope that you find Class Dojo to be a convenient and exciting way of being made aware of how your child is displaying positive behaviours in school. We hope you enjoy connecting with us and your child / children through Class Dojo to see all of the positive behaviours they display around school.
