

Year 4 have also made some Fantasy Story books with beautifully painted covers!

### School Information

**Uniform** - Please make sure that all pieces of your child's uniform are named.... there have been several lost items over the past few weeks! Girls are allowed to wear flat, black, plain ankle boots during the Autumn Term. Please ensure that children come to school in the correct footwear (no trainers, apart from on PE days, long boots, or high heels please). After half term, children will be expected to wear our 'Winter Uniform' – boys will need to wear a shirt and tie and girls will no longer be allowed to wear Summer dresses. Please do not hesitate to ask your child's class teacher if you have any questions about uniform.

**Hot dinners** – you are now able to order a hot lunch for your child on ParentPay. The hot meals are delivered into school and are proving to be very popular!

**Holidays** - If you are planning to travel abroad during half term, please check the quarantine guidance extremely carefully on your return– please ensure that your child does not come to school if as a family you are expected to quarantine.

**Flu vaccination** - The school nursing team will be visiting on Friday 9th October to administer the flu vaccine to all the children whose parents have completed the consent form for this. If you would like your child to have the vaccine at school please ensure the consent form is returned to the nursing team **today**.

**Awards** – If your child has achieved an award out of school please send a photo if they would like to celebrate their award with the rest of the school on Friday mornings during our Celebration Worship. Please send a photo to your child's class teacher by Thursday morning.
