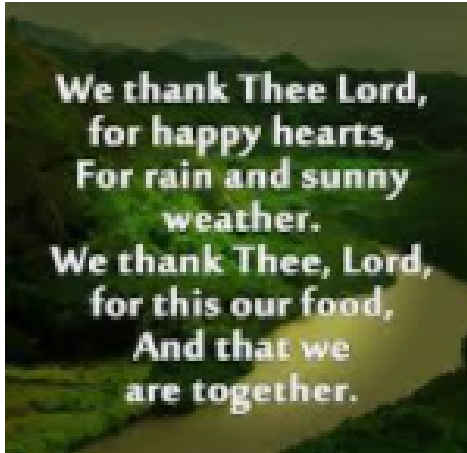


## Freeman's Endowed Church of England Junior Academy Newsletter

#### Awards achieved outside of school

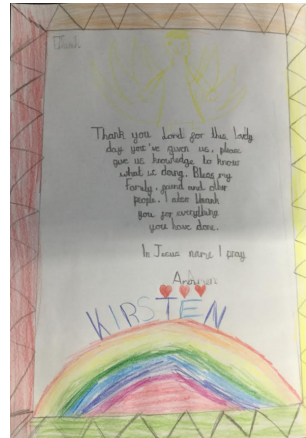
Ruth (Year4): Royal School of Ballet Grade 1 (Merit) and Level 1 Dance Modern Theatre Grade 1 Awards

These prayers will be shared within our daily worship at the end of the day. Here are two prayers written by Jakub and Kirsten.



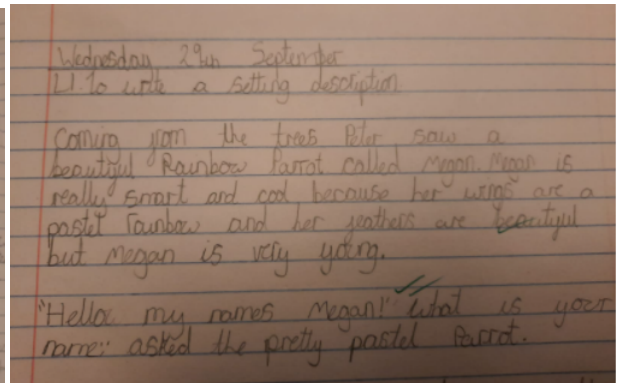
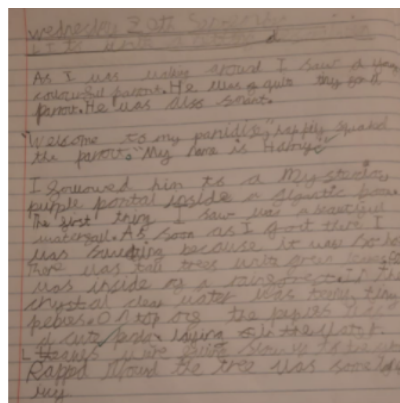
**Art** this week focused on the skill of monoprinting and using different tools and techniques to create line, texture and pattern. Children evaluated the different tools they used and then applied their skills to create a piece of work inspired by Edgar Degas' painting 'A woman seated beside a vase of flowers'.

These beautiful vase paintings were created by Ruth, Edie, Marija and Julia.



We are so incredibly proud of our children. Having had a period of home learning, children returned to school to plan and write a section of a story with a focus on descriptive language of the setting. The work produced was of a fabulous standard, the presentation was amazing and the atmosphere the children created with their vocabulary would entice anybody to a rainforest!

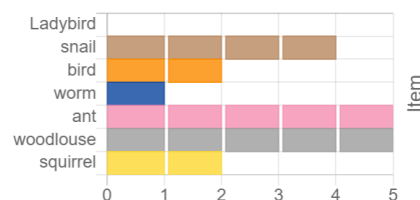

Finally, our year 4's have been into our garden area during our **Science** session to search for signs or vertebrates and invertebrates. Firstly, we clarified the meaning of these words and researched examples of them, then the children created tally charts to be able to collect data of the different insects and animals they saw, classifying them as vertebrates or invertebrates. They were particularly excited by the woodlice and the squirrel seen. The children then used a computer program called 2graph to present their findings. We had a fabulous afternoon during which the children demonstrated incredible behaviour and our school values brilliantly. They were very respectful of our environment and Gods' living creatures. A special well done to Finley and Brogan for your fabulous explanations in class and to Daniella for presenting her data.
